the necessary RSVPs or payment. Another reminder email was sent out so I am hopeful y'all got the message and notified Norma that you will be at the party.

So, what's new with Fort Irwin? We received notice just after mid-March that Team RWB (RedWhiteBlue) at Fort Irwin is hosting the 32nd annual Bataan Memorial Death March in Yermo, CA, (near Peggy Sue's Diner) earlier in the day on April 17th. See article on Page 12.

2021 marks the 72nd anniversary of the Bataan Death March. On April 9 1942, tens of thousands of American and Filipino soldiers were surrendered to Japanese forces and forced to march more than 60 miles in the scorching heat through the Philippine jungles. Thousands died and those who survived faced the hardships of prisoner of war camps. The POWs would not see freedom until 1945 when U.S.-Filipino forces recaptured the lost territory. During the Bataan Death March, approximately 10,000 men died.

The Bataan Memorial Death March event in Yermo is open to the public at no cost to participate.



Marchers will honor the heroic service members who defended the Philippine Islands during WWII, sacrificing their freedom, health, and in many cases, their very lives. Participants will choose between one of two courses: the full 26.2-mile marathon length or the 14.2-mile honorary length. These are not numerous laps around a track surrounding a football field. Both challenging courses will take marchers through the high desert terrain up into the Calico hills above Yermo. The event information listed various sponsorship opportunities and one jumped out as something Inland Mopars could support with a minimum of club member participation. I felt this was an important consideration because of our annual "Unholiday" party scheduled for later in the day.

Inland Mopars is sponsoring a 'Water Stop' station on one of the courses. We will have individual bottles of water and energy bars available for the marchers. Because of our scheduled "Unholiday" party later in the day I asked for, and was granted, sponsorship of the first water stop so we will be able to break it down early and head home.

Fort Irwin Team RWB graciously offered to make this our first Toy Drive event of 2021 and will provide a collection box at the event registration and start/finish area. Because of this now being a Toy Drive event Mike Keller will be joining me to help man our Water Stop location. Of course, all club members are welcome to either participate or help support this event. Just be ready for an early morning drive to the desert because this event is scheduled to start at 7:30am and we will have to be there earlier to setup and be ready for the very first group of marchers. Honoring the heroic service members who defended the Philippine Islands during World War II, sacrificing their freedom, health, and, in many cases, their very lives.

The Bataan Death March

On April 9, 1942 tens of thousands of American and Filipino Soldiers were surrendered to Japanese forces and were forced to march more than 60 miles in the scorching heat through the Philippine jungles. Thousands died and those who survived faced the hardships of prisoner of war camps.

The POWs would not see freedom until 1945 when U.S.-Filipino forces recaptured the lost territory.

During the Bataan Death March, approximately 10,000 men died.

This year marks the 79th Anniversary of the Bataan Death March.

Team RWB - Fort Irwin Chapter is hosting the 32nd annual Bataan Memorial Death March on April 17th, 2021. This challenging course will take you through the high desert terrain of Yermo, California.

The location was chosen for ease of access to I-15, hotels and restaurants as well as the proximity to Fort Irwin and Marine Corps Logistics Base Barstow.

Marchers choose between the full 26.2 mile marathon length or a 14.2 mile honorary distance. Participants register for the march at https://bataanmarch.com/. Registration includes access to It's Your Race Virtual Mobile app which will automatically track participants pace, distance and overall time and post it to the Bataan Memorial Death March results page.

32nd Annual Bataan Memorial Death March (cont)

The White Sands Missile Range decision to host the 32nd annual Bataan Memorial Death March virtually for the first time in event history has allowed Team RWB - Fort Irwin the opportunity to host the event in Yermo, CA and bring together veterans, community members, local businesses and organizations.

With the generous support of sponsors and volunteers this event will encourage local participation from the surrounding communities. With this event, Team RWB hopes to encourage comradery amongst its current and future members while honoring the lives lost during the Bataan Death March.
