 - > Updated insurance coverage documents have been received from Hagerty Insurance and copies forwarded to Southwest Carpenters.
 - New requirement from Southwest Carpenters require "COI" (Certificate of Insurance?) from each vendor no later than three weeks before the show date. We received confirmation from Southwest Carpenters that this "COI" applies only to commercial vendors; this requirement does not apply to swappers or non-commercial vendors..
 - > Placement of spectator parking, swappers, show cars, food vendors were discussed as well as entrances. Matt Deane's trailer needs a flat area.
 - We will arrive at 5:00-5:30AM for set up. Flyer says gate open from 7:00-10:00AM and show is 8:00AM-3:30PM. At past shows, cars began lining up at 6:00AM.
 - > (B.J.) No overnight parking allowed per Carpenters Union. Both gates will be unlocked at 5:00AM.
 - > Bring raffle items from the Brander's on Saturday.
 - On Saturday, some of prep will be done on site, other to be done at the Brander's such as goodie bags (or this part could be done during the week prior - possibly Wednesday?). We do not have classroom storage as in previous years at CSDR.
 - > We will use club-member owned awnings for shade at the Opportunity Drawing area.
 - Tables: Dave Miller (2) 8-foot, Paul Roddy (2) 6-foot, Ken (1) 6-foot.
 - > Dave Miller has arranged for porta-potties at no cost to Inland Mopars.
 - > Sam Frisby has arranged for DJ Carl to provide music for the day (\$300).
 - Inland Mopars will provide staff shirts to club members working the show.
 - > Show shirts will be sold to show participants and attendees:
 - \$20 each for sizes up to and including XL





32nd Annual Bataan Memorial Death March Part 1

The Bataan Death March

On April 9, 1942 tens of thousands of American and Filipino Soldiers were surrendered to Japanese forces and were forced to march more than 60 miles in the scorching heat through the Philippine jungles. Thousands died and those who survived faced the hardships of prisoner of war camps.

The POWs would not see freedom until 1945 when U.S.-Filipino forces recaptured the lost territory.

During the Bataan Death March, approximately 10,000 men died.

This year marks the 79th Anniversary of the Bataan Death March.
