President's Message (cont)

Of course, 'THANK YOU' to the Southwest Council of Carpenters for permitting us to hold our car show on the grounds of their Training Center in Ontario. 'THANK YOU' letters were mailed to both the Executive Board members in Los Angeles and the Executive Board members at Local 909 in Ontario.

The bulk of time at our June 6 club meeting was spent on club member review of our recent car show and discussion on improvements necessary for future car shows. There were several areas of improvement discussed and suggestions provided, but the one area that was discussed the most was club member participation. The "bottom line" conclusion from the discussion was we need more participation in all aspects of our car show to ensure both the success and continuation of our annual charity-benefit car shows.

Although our membership numbers are increasing, Inland Mopars is still a relatively small club and our car show requires a much higher percentage of member participation in order to prevent the bulk of the efforts falling on just a few. We realize there is a small percentage of club members who live outside of the Southern California area and cannot participate in our annual car show because of this. We also realize that there are also going to be a small percentage of club members with either temporary health or family issues that preclude their participation. But the remaining bulk of our club membership should be in attendance and be ready to help in all aspects of the show wherever needed. Please remember, our annual car show supports the club's charitable activities.

Our discussions at the June 6 club meeting also resulted in some great suggestions for improvements and we will be acting on these suggestions throughout the year in order to improve our 21st annual "Mopars in May" charity-benefit car show scheduled for May 15, 2022. It's on the calendar so make sure your time is open and you will be there to help.

Each month, I close this message with the same words. They are always true, but this month they seem to be more apropos. Please don't just skim over them when you get to them.

I plan to send out an updated 2021 Inland Mopars Car Club Event Calendar by email prior to the July 11 club meeting. Our club event schedule starts getting more active in September as our annual Toy Drive events start ramping up.

Please check with the locations you helped secure for our 2020 donation boxes to make sure they are still on board for 2021. We can always use more locations as well. We will discuss this further at the July club meeting.


Announcements/Prior Club Business or Activities


Annual Club Activities/Business Status Reports/Upcoming Events

- 20th Annual Mopars In May Car Show (cont):
 - Members voted to reimburse Jason for all expenses related to the powder coating raffle prize.
 - We sold out of shirts, which was a good thing. There are people still asking about shirts. Bad thing is we would have to order a minimum of 100 for a reorder. We need a count to determine if there will be a reorder.
 - > Members after show observations, suggestions & recommendations:
 - NOT ENOUGH MEMBERS PARTICIPATING. We had 42 total club members × 2 (Most are couples) as of show date. Less than 20 members were working show.
 - It was suggested that the show was too much work for the working club members, with the club participation that we had, and should keep the show at the present size. Could use more help.
 - Sil suggested buddying up with another club for the show. Members thought that it would end up being a conflict of interest between club charities.
 - Sil suggested that Ft. Irwin contribute help with parking, etc., as this is in support of their toy drive.
 - $\circ~$ Cut the size of the opportunity drawing. Too time consuming finding the raffle items for each number.
 - There was no street signage where to park, handicap, show cars, spectators, etc.
 - Porta potties, need more. They ran out of supplies very early (no t.p., hand towels, water at hand wash stations).
 - Modify the layout of the show to improve space efficiency for cars.
 - Switch sides for classic car and modern car parking.
 - \circ Move the vendors to the cement area for more room for cars on grass.
 - Open gates earlier for vendors.
 - Have a hard cut-off time for entries at gate.
 - Revamp the judging forms.
 - Use the legacy window registration forms so class numbers are at the top of the form and can be seen. Use legacy color forms to differentiate judged & display.
 - Have enough judges for each class.
 - More food vendors.





Mopars in May 2021 had a new location & a new date. The location changed from the California School for the Deaf, Riverside to the Southwest Carpenters Training Center in Ontario. Normally held the third Sunday in May, 2021 was moved to the fourth Sunday to accommodate the Grand National Roadster Show, usually held in January but due to Covid, had moved to May 14-16. (Inland Mopars has been working the GNRS souvenir booth since 2003 as a club fund raiser.) The new location & date change didn't seem to deter many. With 286 show vehicles and a sold out vendor/swap area, you got the idea that people were tired of not being able to go to a car show, whether to actually participate or spectate. 



Ft. Irwin Toy Drive 2021

The toy drive for Ft. Irwin officially kicked off at the Mopars in May Car Show. We collected seven boxes of toys plus cash donations of \$230. We are next scheduled to be at the Automobile Driving Museum on August 28th with the toy booth, info & donation jar. Saturday September 4th of Labor Day weekend there will be a toy drive at the Inglis Classics Open House & Car Show in Hesperia. October 30th will be the Champion Cooling Car Show, again benefitting the Ft. Irwin toy drive, at a new location.
