 - 501(C)(7) -SOCIAL ORGANIZATION; "A social club must be organized for pleasure, recreation, and other similar purposes. A club will not be recognized as tax exempt if it's charter, bylaws or other governing instrument, or written policy statement provides for discrimination against any person based on race, color, or religion". (*Does not say anything about what make of car they drive.*). Can accept charitable donations of funds and items. Will have to file a simple tax form every year.
 - Discussion about possible lawyer and/or CPA to set up account. Sam will get more info.

 - Ken went over the results of the questionnaire that Ed Sobiecki had presented in July.

MOPARS IN MAY PARTICIPANT SURVEY RESULTS

Ed Sobiecki comments: Due to the small response rate of participants (only 7%), I have only provided results that show significant percentages of respondents in each area.

Number of Classes of Cars:

- 69% felt that the number of classes of cars was fine.
- 12% wanted more A-Body classes
- 6% wanted more B-Body; 6% wanted more late models
- 6% wanted fewer E-Body classes

Vendors:

- 56% wanted more food vendors. Examples were In-N-Out, BBQ burger & hotdog.
- 38% were okay with the number of vendors
- 6% wanted fewer random vendors that weren't car related

Opportunity Drawings:

- 100% loved it!
- 12% said they wanted more car stuff, tools.

Pace of Show:

- 63% thought the pace was all right, considering the size of the show.
- 25% thought it was too long.
- 12% wanted the trophies presented earlier (yeah, right).

The comments on the show were very positive. Most people said they really loved the venue, and they hoped we could have the same site next year. Other positive comments remarked on the opportunity drawings. Negative comments addressed the need for more water for washing, more porta-potties, and more food vendors. The most common negative comment was that we should make provisions to separate the pre-registered and day-of-entry cars to facilitate parking in the morning. This has already been addressed in the form we sent out with the survey where we mentioned things we were already going to change for next year.

MuscleCars at the Strip (MATS) submitted by Jason Gibbons

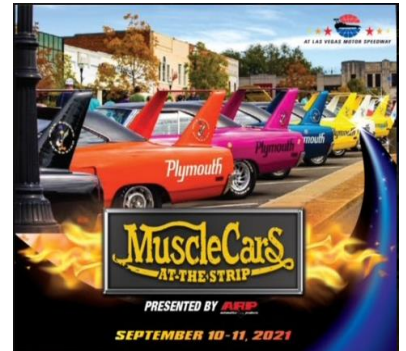

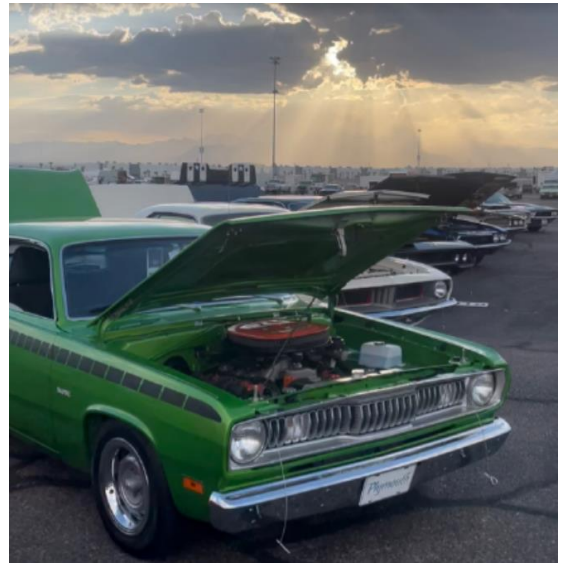

Overall, there were less than 125 cars, but still a cool event, when you have all these features at a show, it doesn't get much better.



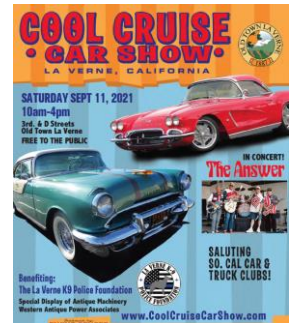

Grand National Roadster Show (GNRS)



As Ken mentioned in his President's Message, we will again be working the GNRS as the annual club fund raiser. For those newer members, the GNRS is usually held the last weekend in January. It is where the America's Most Beautiful Roadster trophy is awarded so there are some high dollar cars there. Don't be confused by the name of the show thinking this is an all roadster show. The show is open to all kinds of cars.

Our role in this show is we work the souvenir booth for the days they are open. We usually take the show hours each day, add an hour before & an hour after, and then split it in half. It usually ends up being 5-6 hours. It isn't hard work but it can get crazy busy on Friday & Saturday. If you work the booth you get free parking as well as entry into the show so plan on viewing the cars either before or after your shift.

We also do an Inland Mopars club display with 3-4 member cars on display inside the secure building for the weekend. This year's display cars belong to Jason Gibbons, 1970 Plymouth Duster; John Smithson, 1965 Plymouth Satellite; Chris Thompson, 1970 Plymouth Superbird, and if ready, Sil Brander, 1984 Hellcat powered Dodge Rampage (Rambo). We have a couple of event flyer racks in the display for Mopar events as well as open show events. An entry form for the Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday Drive-in is available at Rodshows.com, or ask me, in case you want to be part of the weekend show. Sign-up days & times shown below. The Canyon RV park is in Featherly Park. Entrance to the park is directly across from the west bound freeway exit.



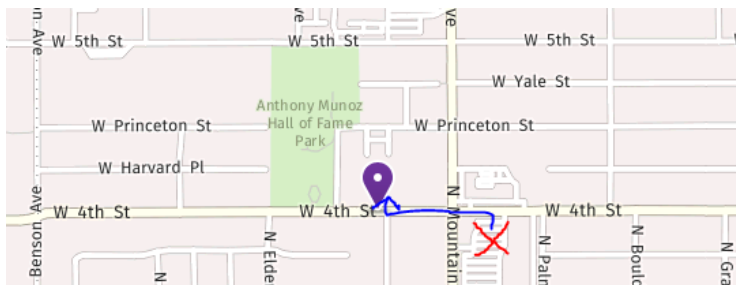
