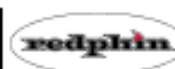

## Grand National Roadster Show (GNRS) Again

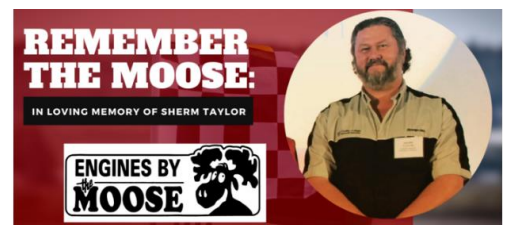


