- Any pictures of Color Guard? Horses. This year they from the 11<sup>th</sup> Armored Cavalry Regiment. Black Horse Cavalry Color Gard showed up in 1901 uniforms with a couple of horses. Ken gave us a little history: they were first organized in 1901. They have been the opposing force at Fort Irwin since 1994 and are considered the best trained mechanized force in the World.
- > Comments, recommendations for next year? Debbie Whitson recommended music. Three years ago, there was a band. But we didn't want the expense this time. Don's PA wasn't working this year, so no music or announcements. Voted no on band next year (2022).
- After action meeting with the Longs; Mike sent e-mail to the Longs about the party since we might have some comments.
- Toy Drive update
  - Mike refreshed us about the Cruise-In with the Clauses at the Zimmerman Automobile Driving Museum in El Segundo on Saturday December 4<sup>th</sup> as reported at the December meeting.
  - > Sunday morning before the club meeting, Mike unloaded 20 boxes of toys at toy storage.
  - > Sunday evening December 5<sup>th</sup> Mike went to the South Bay Mopars Annual Holiday Party in Torrance where they had collected toys and a couple of bikes for us.
  - Monday December 6<sup>th</sup> Mike started picking up donation boxes and made another toy delivery to toy storage.
  - > Tuesday was another day of picking up donation boxes.
  - Wednesday December  $8^{th}$  was toy trailer loading at the Branders. First thing that happened was the up/down mechanism on the trailer broke. We still hitched it up and moved it while Sil found a replacement part. Bill & Debbie Whitson, Lonnie & Robin Clabaugh, Jim Froelich, & Mike made short work of loading the trailer. It was probably  $\frac{3}{4}$  full with the boxes and 7 bikes out of the storage shed. Mike took the loaded trailer to the Long's in Corona so Don could place it for the Saturday party.
  - > Friday Mike picked up another box & toys in Alhambra.
  - > Saturday was the toy drive party & pot luck.
  - Sunday Mike drove to El Cajon to pick up the bike & scooter trailer from Hilton Vail containing 60 bikes & 40 scooters. He delivered the trailer to the Long's where Michael Harding & Ken Hamer would pick it up the following Sunday for delivery to Fort Irwin. Mike picked up the now full toy trailer which had been filled the night before.
  - > Wednesday December 15<sup>th</sup> Mike delivered the full toy trailer to Fort Irwin for unloading. Delivery had been scheduled for Tuesday but was changed for safety reasons; rain & high winds. We had 2 lines of people unloading and it took less than 30 minutes to unload the trailer into the Fort Irwin containers for later sorting.
  - > Thursday December 16<sup>th</sup> Mike took the empty trailer to the Highway 39 Event Center in Anaheim for that evening's toy drive and car show. Bill & Debbie Whitson, along with Bill's brother Barrie and his wife Marsha, came out for the event. Bring a toy, get a dinner. Just before 9:00 pm we started to box toys up but didn't quite make it before the rain came.

- Toy Drive Update (cont):
  - Highway 39 Event Center (cont) We filled over 25 boxes full of toys plus loaded 50 small bikes in boxes donated by the Highway 39 Event Center.
  - > Saturday December 18<sup>th</sup> Mike went the Holiday Car Show & toy drive in Apple Valley put together by Tanya Inglis of Inglis Classics in Hesperia. They had about 80 registered vehicles from eleven car clubs and independents. Former member Scott Seese, his girlfriend and her mother, helped box up the toys and load the trailer with eight more boxes of toys. The trailer was moved to Mike's in-laws in Hesperia for the night.
  - Sunday December  $19^{th}$  Paul Roddy met Mike at his house for the drive up to Hesperia to pick up the truck & trailer for delivery to Fort Irwin. In the meantime, Michael Harding met Ken Hamer at the Long's to pick up the bike & scooter trailer for delivery to Fort Irwin. Michael & Ken beat us to the Fort Irwin visitor center parking lot. We notified SGM Killea we were there and he sent an escort vehicle out to get us in. The bike trailer was unloaded first followed by the  $\frac{1}{4}$  full toy trailer. Michael took the empty bike trailer back to Corona and Mike took the empty toy trailer to Ontario.
  - Monday December 20th Mike to Sil's trailer back to San Jacinto.
  - > Tuesday December 21<sup>st</sup> Mike went to Corona to pick up the empty bike trailer and then returned it to Hilton Vail in El Cajon. Now without a trailer Mike stopped in Murrieta at MoTech Performance to deliver their appreciation plaque. He also stopped at Overdriven Performance in the same complex to thank them. They had the Champion Cooling toy donation box and had already received their appreciation plaque. Both are on board for 2022.
  - > Wednesday December 22<sup>nd</sup> Mike went the 909 Camaros meeting/meet & greet in Highland and presented them with their appreciation plaque. They are also on board for 2022.
  - > All appreciation plaques were hand delivered except for one, which was done by mail as requested.

  - Mike announced that Saturday, January 8<sup>th</sup> was toy distribution at Ft. Irwin from noon to 4pm. Anybody wanting to go must have CDL to Mike by Monday to go. Two hour drive, min.
