President's Message

Club Member Support & Participation

There was a discussion at our March club meeting regarding the future of our annual "Mopars In May" charity club car show. The discussion was member-driven and centered around the fact that we need more club member participation at our annual car show.

Here is the 'bottom line':

We need participation from more of our club members.

As with most organizations we have a small group of members who do the bulk of the work. Unfortunately, none of us are getting any younger and our annual car show requirements seem to take more of a toll on those working the show each succeeding year.

At the close of the discussion, I said that I would send out an email to each club member family in California and Arizona that has paid their 2022 club membership dues asking their opinion on continuing our car show and also asking for their commitment to work the car show if the club membership decides to continue with the show. I advised that if we did not receive commitments from 50% of our current club membership then the car show would immediately be cancelled and all entry monies received to date would be returned. The deadline for email replies was set at March 26 so we will know the results at our April 3rd club meeting.

At the time I sent the email, the list of dues-paid club member families included 29 families and a total of 49 individuals.

In addition to our club members, we always have some members from The Mopar Club of San Diego who volunteer to help with judging the entries to our car show.

We have also requested some assistance from our main charity beneficiary, Fort Irwin.

Please plan to attend our April 3rd club meeting to learn the results of our club member decision. I will also have current car show entry information ready for discussion.

Shortly after sending out the above-mentioned email, we received notice from our 2021 Car Show Chairman, Jason Gibbons, that he was

 - > April 30th Grace Yokley School Music Car Show in Ontario. Benefits the school music program. So far Mike and Bill are going.
- Mopars in May May 15th at the Southwest Carpenters Training Center in Ontario.
 - Lots of discussion about the pre-registration only. The plan right now is to turn people away if not registered. It was mentioned that what do we do if we don't fill the spots? Do we open it up until we do? There was a discussion about opening it up.
 - Most said there was not enough participation to run the show. Suggestion was made about talking to 909 Mopars to see if they would help out. DC asked how many members at the meeting are willing to help. If everyone there attended then it should be a go. Mike had sent an email to Fort Irwin asking if they might have some volunteers that might want to help with the show. They had responded that they would check.

 - help with shirt booth
 - help with parking
 - helping totaling up judging sheets, organizing numbers and names
 - help handing out awards
 - Mike then asked how many bodies should we ask for? Sil suggested a minimum commitment of 4-8 members to show up at 5am. Lonnie suggested that we team up with whatever help they send.
 - Paul suggested that any soldiers who come to work the show should get free entry of their cars.
 - > DC said if we get more help could we still take day of show? And Ken is this something we want to think about. DC suggested again that the gate stay open to anyone with money.
 - > Color guard if available. Ken asked if Mike turned in paper work for the color guard. Holding for Jason to sign.

- > Need bodies to stay & help clean up after the show. This includes packing the trailer with anything left over.
- > Another planning meeting was suggested to discuss in more detail day of show registration and judging. Meeting will again be at Paul's house.
- Mike had sent an email with the December newsletter in February that if dues were not paid, the December newsletter would be the last newsletter you will get. Ken wants to email unpaid and past members about why they haven't renewed to get a feeling of any possible issues.
- Leo asked about local members needing to come to a few meetings a year and a few club activities to help boost member participation. Response was what do you want to do, kick them out?
- May 28th A Flag for Every Hero at Riverside National Cemetery.
- 2022 Fort Irwin Toy Drive Potential fund raiser item Pedal Car. Leanna Johnson from Phoenix Specialty Coatings, wanted to decorate, but Ken hadn't been able to contact her yet to find out specifics. Ken asked if we still wanted to do it. No decision made yet since we don't know what will be involved or thoughts were on what to do with it once done.




