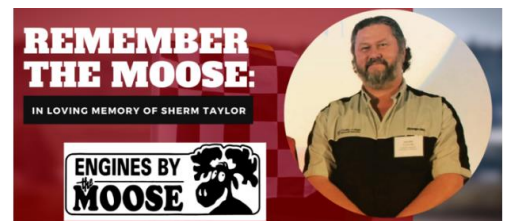
**Sherm Taylor Scholarship Endowment**

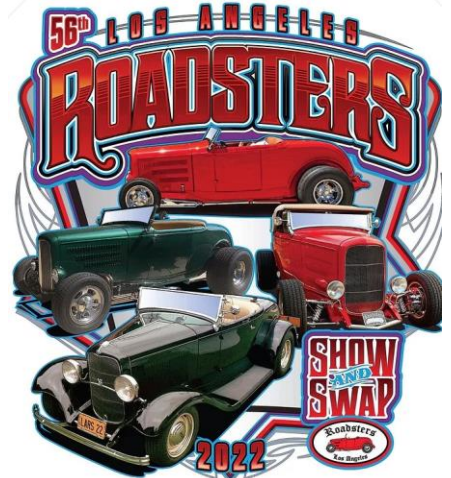
