19th Annual Classic Car Show

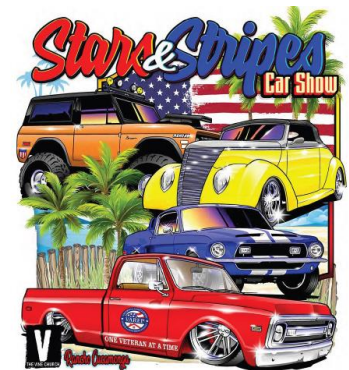

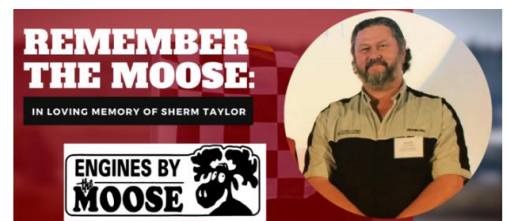
Sherm Taylor Scholarship Endowment

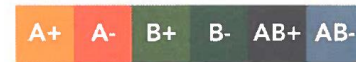




