turbocharged 1968 Dart and won his class. Congratulations Chris! I saw a photo online of Chris holding his 'big win check'. Check with Chris the next time you see him for stories about the event.

At the "Dodge Last Call Powered by Roadkill Nights" event, Dodge did a live reveal of the ultimate, and final, 'Last Call' model of their gasoline-powered performance cars, the Dodge Challenger SRT Demon 170.

Some highlights of this little grocery getter with 'Holy \$#!&' level performance are 1,025 horsepower @ 6,500rpm and 945 lb.-ft of torque @ 4,200 rpm from the 6.2-liter HEMI. This engine, plus all of the other engineered upgrades make this the world's quickest 0-60mph production car at 1.66 seconds. Acceleration like that should require Christmas Tree starting lights rather than generic red-green traffic lights at metered freeway onramps!





The Demon 170 also boasts the highest g-force acceleration of any production car at 2.004 *Gs* and is history's first-ever eight-second factory muscle car at 8.91 seconds elapsed time at 151.17mph. In fact, NHRA has already banned the Demon 170 in stock form from competition. You will need to install a roll cage before running on a NHRA-sanction dragstrip. Oh yeah, a parachute is available for purchase as a factory option.

Want to order one? Check out https://www.dodgegarage.com/srt-demon-170 to see all the available exterior colors, graphic and interior options. Forged aluminum wheels are standard as are Mickey Thompson® drag radial tires. Carbon fiber wheels are available as an additional \$11,495 option. Pricing you ask? The U.S. MSRP is \$96,666 and only 3,300 will be available for the U.S. market. An additional 300 will be available in Canada with a Canadian MSRP of \$134,785.

And, yes, it does come with a full factory warranty.

You better hurry!
