<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - Sam Frisby gave the treasurer's report for March.


Club Social Media

We hope to see a lot more toys gathered at the toy drive kick off at our Mopars in May Car Show in a couple of weeks. Toys are needed for more than 3100 kids.

We are looking for events to partner with to collect toys for Fort Irwin. If you know of anyone looking to hold an event we should contact, please let me know. It is best to be at the planning stages so the toy drive info gets on the promotional materials and flyers, otherwise no one knows to bring a toy.

We are also always looking for businesses that would like to have a toy donation box at their business location. This works best where the business has a lot of repeat foot traffic. We had tried CDJR dealerships but most didn't have the repeat traffic or box placed where it would be seen.



As you can see from the schedule below, the toy drive consumes months of planning and coordination between clubs, businesses, toy donation box locations, as well as Fort Irwin. Planning started a while ago for 2023. We did lose the Riverside Cars & Coffee when J&M Speed Center in Riverside closed in March.
