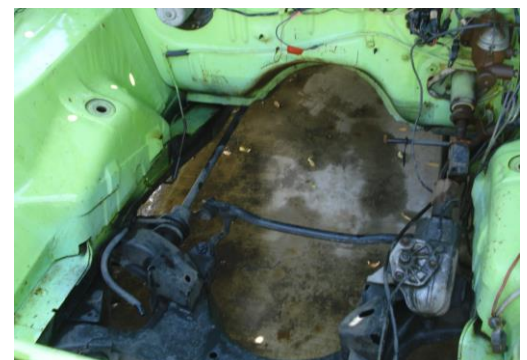

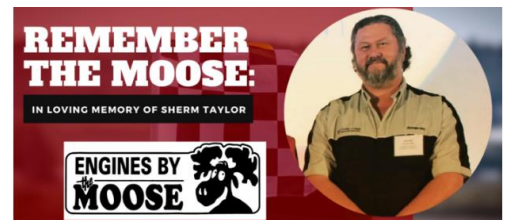
Sherm Taylor Scholarship Endowment
