If you put off getting your registration for the upcoming In-N-Out Burger 75th Anniversary celebration, then you are out of luck and will be looking in from outside the fence. An article in the September 20 issue of the *Orange County Register* announced the sellout of the all-day event scheduled for October 22 at the In-N-Out Burger Pomona Dragstrip on the grounds of the Fairplex.

Links to ticket sales have been removed from the website that was set up for the event. Everything involved in the event is officially sold out: general admission, car show entry, drag racing entry as well as a separately ticketed "Rock 2 Freedom" concert headlined by ZZ Top, .48 Special, and the In-N-Out "family band".

The October 22 festival date is a special day in In-N-Out history as it is the exact 75^{th} anniversary date that Harry and Esther Snyder opened the very first In-N-Out in Baldwin Park.

And the date may also be very special for Inland Mopars since we will have our Fort Irwin Toy Drive booth at the festival. Ticket sale totals have not been announced but we do know the dragstrip has a seating capacity of 40,000.

Bits 'n Pieces: Grand National Roadster Show Reminder



In other news, Inland Mopars club member Chris Thompson is once again participating in the 2023 edition of *Hot Rod Drag Week* with his turbocharged 1968 Dodge Dart. The 2023 event schedule started Sunday, September 17, with tech inspection, registration, and Test'N'Tune at Darlington Dragway in Hartsville, SC. Day 1 racing followed at the same location the next day. Followed by Day 2 racing at Rockingham Dragway in Rockingham, NC; Day 3 racing at Bristol Dragway in Bristol, TN; Day 4 racing at Carolina Dragway in in Aiken, SC, and the Day 5 Finals on September 22 back at Darlington Dragway. Sandwiched among the daily racing schedule is maintenance and upkeep and the towing of the parts and maintenance trailer (using the race car as the tow vehicle) to the next venue. That is a total of 685 miles of towing in addition to five consecutive days of racing.





At the close of Day 2 racing at Rockingham Dragway, Chris was in fourth place (out of seven entries) in the "Pro Street - Power Adder" class. Two of the class entries were already out because of parts/vehicle breakage). Chris' Dart had run a best of 8.725 @ 157.84. Check with Chris the next time you see him for stories about the event.


Conditions on the 10 Freeway & 60 Freeway are unknown at this time. You never know when they will be closed for bridge work so plan ahead.



Fort Irwin Toy Drive

We are still looking for events to partner with to collect toys for Fort Irwin. If you know of anyone looking to hold an event that we should contact please let me know. It is best to be at the planning stages so the toy drive info gets on the promotional materials and flyers otherwise no one knows to bring a toy.

We are also always looking for businesses that would like to have a toy donation box at their business location. This works best where the business has a lot of repeat foot traffic. Restaurants work well so if you have a favorite, let me know. We had tried CDJR dealerships but most didn't have the repeat traffic or box placed where it would be seen.

As you can see from the schedule below, the toy drive consumes months of planning and coordination between clubs, businesses, toy donation box locations, as well as Fort Irwin. Planning started a while ago for 2023. We did lose J&M Speed Center in Riverside when they closed in March but the Riverside Cars & Coffee cruise is still taking place at the J&M site. Infinite Hero is looking for a new location for their Heroes & Hot Rods show when the previous location in Anaheim said they were no longer able to accommodate the event. But we did gain Bruster's Real Ice Cream, the In-N-Out Burgers 75th Anniversary Festival, and the Flabob Airport Veterans Celebration.


