But first, a couple of reminders:

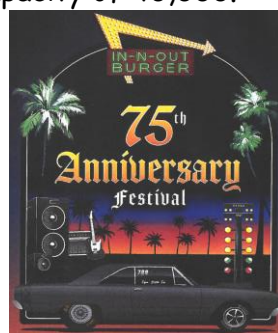
- *Sam Frisby will happily accept your 2023 club dues if you haven't yet paid them...and maybe even your 2024 club dues if you want to pay early*

If you put off getting your registration for the upcoming In-N-Out Burger 75th Anniversary celebration, then you are out of luck and will be looking in from outside the fence. An article in the September 20 issue of the *Orange County Register* announced the sellout of the all-day event scheduled for October 22 at the In-N-Out Burger Pomona Dragstrip on the grounds of the Fairplex.

Links to ticket sales have been removed from the website that was set up for the event. Everything involved in the event is officially sold out: general admission, car show entry, drag racing entry as well as a separately ticketed "Rock 2 Freedom" concert headlined by ZZ Top, .48 Special, and the In-N-Out "family band".

The October 22 festival date is a special day in In-N-Out history as it is the exact 75th anniversary date that Harry and Esther Snyder opened the very first In-N-Out in Baldwin Park.

And the date may also be very special for Inland Mopars since we will have our Fort Irwin Toy Drive booth at the festival. Ticket sale totals have not been announced but we do know the dragstrip has a seating capacity of 40,000.

Our two entries for the Grand National Roadster Show in 2023 were Bill Heckman's 1969 Plymouth Road Runner & Mike Keller's 1971 Dodge Demon. So far we have two entries for the 2024 show. Bill & Debbie Whitson have volunteered to enter their 1964 Plymouth Fury and Bill Heckman has volunteered to enter his 1966 Dodge Coronet. A third vehicle would be nice to fill up the Inland Mopars club display. Mike has the Indoor Vehicle and Drive-In entry forms. Need to know by October 1st.

In other news, Inland Mopars club member Chris Thompson is once again participating in the 2023 edition of *Hot Rod Drag Week* with his turbocharged 1968 Dodge Dart. The 2023 event schedule started Sunday, September 17, with tech inspection, registration, and Test'N'Tune at Darlington Dragway in Hartsville, SC. Day 1 racing followed at the same location the next day. Followed by Day 2 racing at Rockingham Dragway in Rockingham, NC; Day 3 racing at Bristol Dragway in Bristol, TN; Day 4 racing at Carolina Dragway in Aiken, SC, and the Day 5 Finals on September 22 back at Darlington Dragway. Sandwiched among the daily racing schedule is maintenance and upkeep and the towing of the parts and maintenance trailer (using the race car as the tow vehicle) to the next venue. That is a total of 685 miles of towing in addition to five consecutive days of racing.



At the close of Day 2 racing at Rockingham Dragway, Chris was in fourth place (out of seven entries) in the "Pro Street - Power Adder" class. Two of the class entries were already out because of parts/vehicle breakage). Chris' Dart had run a best of 8.725 @ 157.84. Check with Chris the next time you see him for stories about the event.

We will soon be in our busiest part of the year with a number of Fort Irwin Toy Drive events. Please plan to help whenever you can. Also, please be on the lookout for announcements regarding planning meetings for our 2024 "Mopars in May" charity benefit car show scheduled for Sunday, May 19, 2024

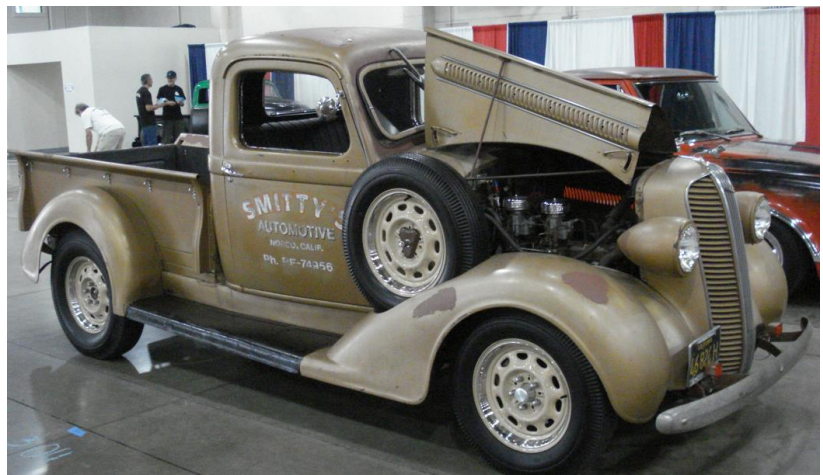

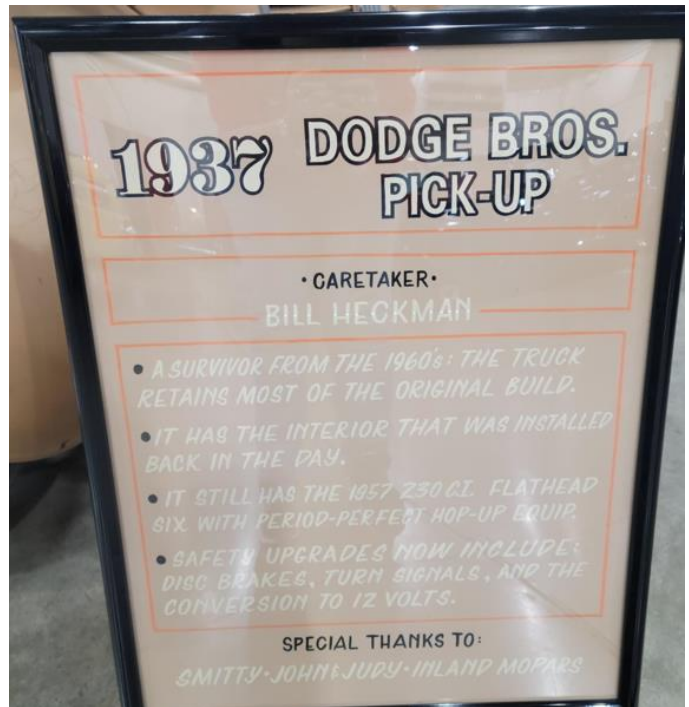

Ontario Elks Car Show & Meeting, Sunday October 1st

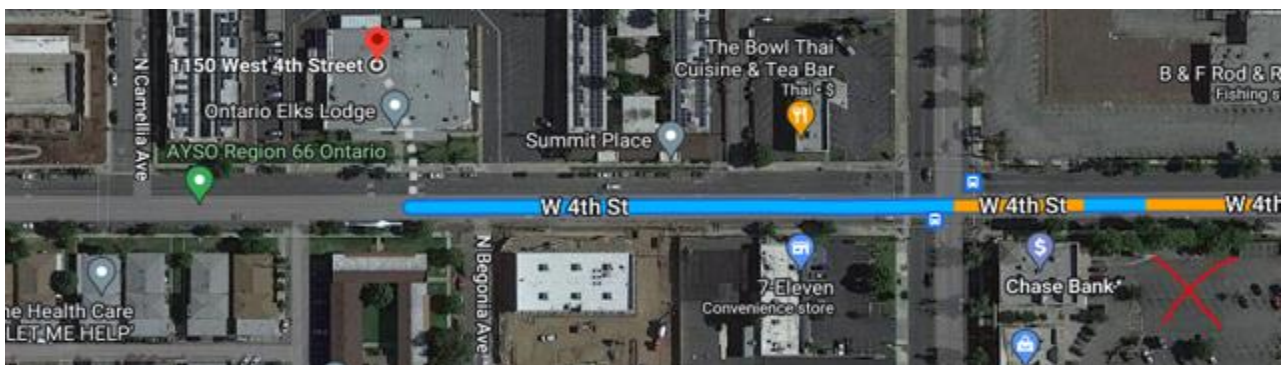
Sunday October 1st show entrants meet at the south east corner parking lot at 4th & Mountain at 6:30, leave at 6:45. It is a short drive across Mountain to the Elks on the right at 1150 W. 4th Street Ontario, CA 91762

Conditions on the 10 Freeway & 60 Freeway are unknown at this time. You never know when they will be closed for bridge work so plan ahead.

If you are just attending the meeting, you may have to drive past the car show site to find parking at the park at the next street on the right, which is N. Camellia Ave.

For car show participants, from the 10 Fwy, go south on Mountain to 4th Street. Make a left on 4th Street & then a quick right into the parking lot on your right (red X on map).

For car show participants, from the 60 Fwy, go north on Mountain, to 4th Street & make a right then another right into the parking lot on your right (red X on map).

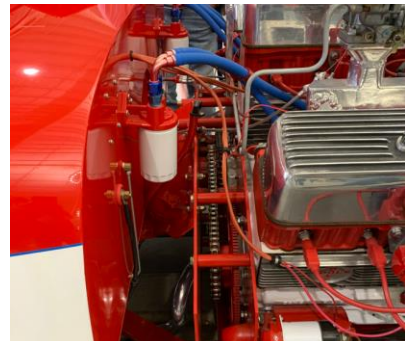

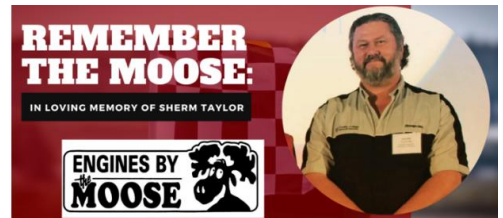
