In case you were unable to attend the January club meeting, please be advised that following an extensive discussion it was decided to postpone our annual "Mopars in May" charity-benefit car show from May 19, 2024, to May 18, 2025. The decision was based on a number of contributing factors but primarily due to receiving a flyer for a "Mopars vs. The World" event at Irwindale Dragstrip scheduled for our traditional third-Sunday-in-May date. The Irwindale event flyer shows a combination of drag racing, car show with awards for both multiple classic Mopar vehicles and modern Mopars, and a swap meet. The flyer also states the Irwindale event will be presented by Full Blown Performance, a primarily modern Mopar performance shop located in Los Angeles.

Elite Mopars Car Club had previously agreed to partner with Inland Mopars to help with our 2024 car show and several representatives were in attendance at our January meeting for car show discussions. They reinforced the opinions of most of the Inland Mopars club members in attendance that the Irwindale event would severely impact the number of both participant entries and spectators to our event. During the continuing discussion we looked at alternate dates in the month of May but decided those dates were not feasible for multiple reasons.

Following the decision to postpone our annual car show to 2025, the representatives from Elite Mopars confirmed their club is fully on board to support and assist with the 2025 edition of "Mopars in May".

Not having a 2024 edition of "Mopars in May" will impact both our club treasury funds and our purchasing power to support our 2024 Fort

In other news, the Mullin Automotive Museum located in Oxnard announced they will be closing their doors on February 10, 2024, after being in operation for 13 years. The closure is due to the passing of Peter Mullin in September 2023. The museum was founded by Peter Mullin and his wife Merle Mullin in 2010, and showcased the largest private collection of Bugatti automobiles in the world as well as other French cars from the 1930s, furniture, and art from the Art Deco movement. The announcement said four cars from the museum's collection will be transferred to the Petersen Automotive Museum. There is no information yet on what will happen to the rest of the automobiles and art.

It is sad to see such a unique and beautiful museum close down. However, the Mullin Automotive Museum will always be remembered for its contribution to the preservation of French automotive history and art.

Plan your trip to Oxnard if you want to visit this museum before it is lost forever.

Because the Grand National Roadster Show is happening over the first weekend of February, the next club meeting is scheduled for Sunday, February 11, in the banquet room at Cactus Cantina restaurant in Riverside. Fort Irwin Toy Drive photos submitted by Norma Johnston, Mike Keller

Whew...the toy drive, the actual task of collecting toys, was over after the December 16th Santa's Rock'n Holiday in Apple Valley. On Sunday December 17th, all the collected toys, bikes and sports equipment that had been loaded in the 24-ft trailer, were delivered to the Fort Irwin field house, site of the actual *Christmas in January* toy distribution event scheduled for Saturday January 6th, when the men & women stationed at Fort Irwin, had returned from their *Christmas leave*.

So, Saturday January 6th, Bill & Debbie Whitson, Norma Johnston, Ken Hamer & Mike Keller met at the Fort Irwin visitor center parking lot to head in together. In the past we had requested someone meet us and escort us in, eliminating a hold up at the gate. With only two vehicles and five people, what could go wrong since we had already sent copies of our IDs in? How about a computer freeze? A couple of phone calls later we were on our way. We had factored in some extra time so we wouldn't be late and we weren't.



We unloaded a couple more boxes of late toys and a bike then headed in to check things out and take a few photos before the actual distribution started. Inside the field house were four sets of tables, each designated boy or girl and ages. They didn't use quite as many tables this year as in the past so each set of tables were stacked with toys, not as spread out as in the past.

Christmas in January used to be held outside in the town center with a 30-ft Christmas and sleigh with Santa. Covid put an end to that. It is now a drive thru type event so they can now serve four families at a time, rather than one at a time in a single sleigh with Santa, knocking a couple of hours off the event.



Partial view of the 0-5 age kid's toys stacked three & four high. Kids in the first couple of rows would do the actual selecting of toys for the kids in the drive thru lanes. They had a good time & did a good job. Most of the Inland Mopars members are at the far right, next to Col. Bomar.

So the procedure now is a family vehicle is directed into the event by the MPs into a line where they get a card which they would fill out with the kid's age(s) and boy/girl. They are directed to one of four lanes where they were lined up. When the distribution actually starts, a runner goes to the first vehicle in each line and gets the card with the kid's info and heads into the field house where all the toys are arranged. Inside the field house, the runner & picker find the correct age group(s) that match the info on the card and choose a couple of items for each person on the card. The runner then takes those toys to the vehicle and hand them to the parent or child. That vehicle would then be motioned to pull out and the next vehicle would move forward and it is all done over again. If there was a bike indicated on the card, the vehicle would be directed to the bike loading area and the appropriate bike would be loaded in or on the vehicle. The MPs would direct the vehicle back onto the street and off they would go. A couple of hours later the four lanes are down to one and everyone can relax a little.
