More interesting online news reports that CrossHarbor Capital, a Boston-based investment firm that specializes in commercial real estate, is in the closing stages of purchasing Willow Springs International Raceway, all 600 acres and all seven tracks on the property, the cinderblock office and garage buildings, maintenance equipment, and even the snack bar famous for serving hot dogs and fried fish sandwiches. A statement from the firm reads, "While CrossHarbor Capital cannot provide details on acquisitions before they are complete, we can confirm that a deal is pending and the team is excited to preserve the legacy and enthusiast access to one of America's most iconic racing facilities while also setting up the property for growth and success in the future. More details will be released soon." It's too soon to speculate about the firm's intentions for the beloved race track, which opened in 1953, though the carefully worded statement gives us hope that its legacy and "enthusiasts' access" to the facility will remain a top priority. The iconic track continues to transport its many fans to a time when American road racing was producing legendary drivers who took on Europe's finest; a time when names like "Ken Miles" were permanent fixtures at Willow. Just my opinion, but Willow Springs should be a protected historic landmark.










Fort Irwin Toy Drive




